



COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Objective:

To promote goodwill within the Independent Insurance Agents of Broward County by providing a monetary scholarship (maximum \$1,000) to the child or grandchild of an employee of any IIABC Agency or Company member in good standing, or intern of any IIABC Agency Member in good standing, who is a college-bound high school senior and has demonstrated a high standard of conduct, both academically and through extracurricular activities.

Qualifications - Nominees must:

- Be the child or grandchild of an employee of any IIABC Agency or Company member in good standing, or intern of any IIABC Agency Member in good standing.
- Be a high school senior who has been accepted by any accredited college or university.
- Have demonstrated high standards of conduct academically and through extracurricular activities.

Selection Criteria:

Current IIABC members may submit nominations to the IIABC office by April 1, 2025. The Scholarship Committee will select nominees based on the following criteria:

- Nominees who are interested in a business degree and will be a full-time student,
- Nominees must demonstrate academic achievement above and beyond their peers with at least a 3.5 grade point average or its equivalent, and
- Nominees who have participated in high school or community extracurricular activity through meaningful and exemplary involvement above and beyond the performance of others involved.
- The committee will review the submissions along with other nominations submitted.
- If awarded, the IIABC scholarship funds will be sent directly to the college. The full name and address of the college, along with the student identification number, must be emailed to iiabc@iiabc.com by August 15, 2025. Failure to provide this information by the deadline will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

The following attachments must be emailed to iiabc@iiabc.com to be considered for scholarship. All items must be received by the deadline or the application will be disqualified:

1. Completed and signed application (two pages).
2. Copy of current school transcript, including GPA and service hours.
3. Brief resume highlighting school achievements, special awards and community activities.
4. Essay describing your accomplishments and career goals.
5. Recent photograph in JPG format (current class picture preferred).

Application Deadline: April 1, 2025. All required documents must be submitted via email by the application deadline; otherwise, the application will be disqualified.

Deadline to Claim Scholarship Funds: Any scholarship awarded must be claimed by August 15th of the year your scholarship is awarded, or scholarship is forfeited. If awarded, the IIABC scholarship funds will be sent directly to the college. The full name and address of the college, along with the student identification number, must be emailed to iiabc@iiabc.com by August 15, 2025. Failure to provide this information by the deadline will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
